Visit to the state-of-the-art production plant (blocks and panels) of Türk Ytong, Istanbul



Türk Ytong was established in 1963 by a group of engin-eers and investors led by Bülent Demiren, an entrepreneurial engineer, in partnership with Sweden's Ytong International AB, by the approval of the Council of Ministers. Türk Ytong started production in 1965 in its first factory in Istanbul-Pendik with a capacity of 50.000 m³.

Today, a total of six plants with a production capacity of up to 2.5 million m³ of Ytong and 50.000 m³ of Multipor operate in Turkey in a 25 percent partnership with the Xella Group. Türk Ytong is Turkey's leading and one of the world's leading AAC producers.
